Bible Quiz, Science Fair, Art

Art and Science Fair projects may be checked in Thursday morning until 12:00 noon. We suggest you send the art and science projects with your Bible quiz team and have Bible quiz students or parent volunteers from your school set up the science fair projects. All art and science projects must be checked in by 12:00 p.m. and will be judged Thursday afternoon. This will allow projects to be available for display during the day Friday.

EVENT FORMAT

The Junior High event follows a competition format with place finishes. In the category of Bible Quiz, a first place trophy will be given. In the categories of Band, Choir, Choral Group, Handbell/Handchime Choir, Readers Theater, and Choric Speaking, a first place certificate will be given. All other categories will result in individual place ribbons (1st, 2nd, 3rd) with recognition also given to Superior ratings (IACS FAB A Guidelines for 2012, page 5).

Schools unable to test on this date due to scheduling issues must contact the host site to arrange an alternate testing date.
