First Round Format: Best 2 out of 3 Sets 1 & 2: to 25, cap 30
Set 3: to 15, no cap, win by 2.

Division 1 – Pool Play Format - Each team will be seeded (#1-#8); Pool Play will consist of 2 pools of 4 teams. Red pool will be seeds 1, 4, 5, 8 and Blue pool will be seeds 2, 3, 6, 7.

Tournament Notes

- ⇒ **Warm-up times:** before 1st match, 7 1/2 and 7 1/2 minutes; before other matches, 5 & 5 minutes. **Each team is responsible for bringing their own volleyballs for team warm-ups.** Please mark them properly for retrieval.
- ⇒ Each volleyball team needs to assign **an adult to be a line judge** for Friday's matches. The first team listed is the home team (official scorer) and will provide **an adult to work the electronic scoreboard** for their court for each match.

⇒ **Please make sure volleyball uniforms conform to the IACS Athletic Policies.**

Definitions

- Students are K5 (Kindergarten) through 12. No charge for preschool. College students are considered adults.
- A family is considered one family unit (parents/guardians and their children). Extended family members are additional units.
- CICC passes are NOT valid for IACS tournament admission.
- Pastors, Administrators, Coaches, Athletic Directors and their spouses are admitted free but will need to sign in at the gate table and will also need a hand stamp each day.
- Pastors are defined as any of the pastoral staff from the church associated with one of the participating schools.
- Administrators are defined as the head administrator or principal from a participating school. This does NOT include assistant principals in preschool, elementary or high school.
- Soccer/volleyball players can attend the opposite sport at no charge if they wear their jerseys or team clothing as a tournament team identifier. Players will need to get their hands stamped for access.

Homeschool Rules

Home-schooled students may participate on IACS school athletic teams if they are enrolled in one class at the member school or they regularly attend the school's sponsoring church. (A school without a sponsoring church or with multiple sponsoring churches must choose a single church they want recognized.) The school's annual IACS membership dues must include the dues for the home-school student(s). After the deadline for submitting dues, no home-school student(s) may be added without permission from the IACS athletic committee or the IACS board. The maximum number of home schoolers on a soccer team is 5 and the maximum number on a basketball or volleyball team is 3.
